Quantum Scholarships 2021

- The Scholarships are for excellent, international or national students admitted to a UGA Master 2 program. The amount of the scholarship will be from 4 to 5 k€.
- The call is open to UGA M2 students enrolled in the following lessons of the <u>Quantum Thematic Program of the UGA Graduate School</u>: <u>Quantum Optics</u> and <u>Quantum Condensed Matter</u>.
- Applicants have to be self-supporting students, meaning that students who have already an academic grant or scholarship, or a financial support from another university are not eligible to the Quantum Scholarship.
- Applicants need to apply for the Scholarship by writing a motivation letter in English describing your motivation for Quantum.
- Besides the letter, a comprehensive CV and the L3/bachelor and first year of Master grades are also mandatory to apply.
- The deadline for applying for a scholarship is 17th september 2021.

 of the Quantum Thematic Program, and to Prof. Franck Balestro
 (<u>franck.balestro@neel.cnrs.fr</u>). The title of your email has to be: "Application for

- Receiving the scholarship is conditional on the student fulfilling all admission criteria to the Master 2 programs.
- The jury will be composed of members of the Quantum Thematic Program board.
- Only students who will be selected will be informed via email by October 4th.
